Rules & Regulations

- ^{1.} The organization of the European Draughts Championship 2016 has been allotted by the EDC to the Turkish Draughts Federation (TDF) and will take place from Tuesday, October 18th till Friday, October 28th.
- 2. Following events will be played:
 - (a) XIX European Championship
 - (b) IX European Women Championship
 - (c) XI European Blitz Championship
 - (d) IX European Women Blitz Championship
 - (e) V European Rapid Championship
 - (f) V European Women Rapid Championship
 - (g) I European Superblitz Cup
 - (h) I European Women Superblitz Cup
- 3. General schedule

^{7.} System of competitions:

- (a) European Championship classic games
 - \Rightarrow Game rate: 1h 20' + 1'
 - ⇒ Tournament will be played in Swiss system (on Solkoff), 9 rounds.
- (b) European Championship Rapid:

- \Rightarrow Game rate: 15' + 5"
- ⇒ Tournament will be played in Swiss system (on Solkoff) with maximum 9 rounds. 7 rounds if not more than 20 players, 8 rounds if not more than 30 players.
- (c) European Championship Blitz:
 - \Rightarrow Game rate: 5' + 3"
 - ⇒ Tournament will be played in Swiss system (on Solkoff) with maximum 11 rounds. 7 rounds if not more than 20 players, 8 rounds if not more than 30 players, 9 rounds if not more than 40 players, 10 rounds if not more than 50 players.
- (d) European Superblitz Cup:
 - \Rightarrow Game rate 5'+3" for unlimited number of games to the first win.
 - ⇒ Tournament will be played in Swiss system (on Solkoff) with maximum 9 rounds. 7 rounds if not more than 20 players, 8 rounds if not more than 30 players.
 - ⇒ Final classification:
 - i. according FMJD Annex-III.
 - ii. the result between the tied players
 - iii. lower number of games in wining super-blitz games (faster winners are better)
 - iv. higher number of games in loosing super-blitz games (later losers are better)
- (e) General Rules for all European Championships.
 - ⇒ Final classification according FMJD Annex-III.
 - ⇒ In case of all criteria of challengers for 1st 3 places will be equal, a tie break should be played with 2 blitz games followed by superblitz if necessary.
 - ⇒ All rules concerning games and rights duties of players/referees described in FMJD annexes are valid.
- 8. National teams classification.
 - (a) National teams
 - ⇒ Before the tournament each federation announced up to 5 players as a member of national team (4 for women).

- ⇒ Team classification will be settled up based on results of 3 best members (2 for women) of national team:
 - i. Lowest sum of places
 - ii. if equal highest sum of points
 - iii. if equal higher place of best team player decides
- ⇒ For teams with less than 3 (2 for women) players N+1 to the score will be added for absent players, where N=number of participants in the tournament.
- 9. Competition fees (cash payment):
 - (a) European Championship (classic).
 Entrance fee is 50€ for the first 3 players from the federation. If more players, then for each next (4-...) entrance fee is 100€.
 - (b) Rapid, Blitz and Superblitz.
 Entrance fee is 30€ (each tournament). 50% reduction for the players born in 1998 or later.
 - (c) Paying fee it is federation duty, so amount of fee from Federations will be counted not based on player present in Izmir but based on number of players in applications. Without full participation fee paid by a federation, it is impossible for any player from that federation to play. In case of extraordinary situation, a federation should inform EDC in written about changes. Only in this case fee for not-coming players can be reduced:
 - \Rightarrow 100% if resignation before September 20th
 - \Rightarrow 50% if resignation before October 1st
 - \Rightarrow 0% if resignation after October 1st (it means that it should be paid fully)

^{10.} Accommodation

- (a) Official package: from the dinner October 18th till breakfast October 28th with hotel room (2-3 persons rooms), breakfast, lunch, dinner.
- (b) TDF will pay the costs for 1 male and 1 female player in case of members of FMJD, have no debts and have organised national championship (2015 and/or 2016).

The federation has to inform the EDC which of their players use this special package.

This package is available only for the federations

- (c) For other players/coaches and also accompanying persons, official package costs 40€ per person per day and should be paid at the tournament reception.
- (d) Additional days before/after the event costs 40€ per person per day (with breakfast, lunch, dinner)
- (e) Single rooms available
